Cllr Hutchinson reported that the newly elected Isle of Wight Council was aiming to have fewer Council Meetings cutting them down to 6. It was having fewer committees and that Cabinet members will take decisions. Decisions are still subject to call in and they are doing away with named vote.

Companies want to invest in the Island. There is to be a high quality call centre with up to 600 jobs coming to the Island. The Council is looking at improving Cowes as there is little access on the front. Justice Ministry has promised to shift ownership of Camp Hill to Community for housing and the Island is getting a grant of £9.5 million for access improvements and improved traffic flow. He reported that Cllr Ward has got the Transport Portfolio
